Managing successful FPSO and Oil Rig Projects

1. What are FPSOs and Oil Rigs

The worlds unsustainable demand for oil and gas has created a need for more exploration and production and this typically means more FPSOs and Oil Rigs.

FPSOs (Floating Production Storage Offloading) and Oil Rigs come in many shapes and forms.

2. What is this course about?

While FPSOs and Oil Rigs will at the end of the day be operating at sea, some of the major challenges are actually delivering the FPSO and Oil Rigs to sea. While companies may have invested in hundreds of millions into the project, someone needs to build or convert them into safe working FPSOs and Oil Rigs.

Managing the project is not only crucial but literally a matter of life and death and of profits and losses. A day in delays during construction and conversions could literally cost millions for operators.

This course is about getting that FPSO and/Oil Rig built on time, on budget and without incidents.

3. How will it benefit your company?

4. How will it benefit you as an individual?

Strangely in most cases HSE personnel working on FPSO and Oil Rig projects may not have been from the industry. Yet they are tasked such huge responsibilities.

This course aims to benefit individuals by giving them core skills in managing HSE on FPSO and Oil Rig projects

Not only will it familiarize them with the construction activities but to take the project from construction to commission and handover.



5. What are the opportunities after this course

There are projects around the world. Most FPSO and Oil Rig projects are high value and pay a good salary. Good performance relates to good prospects. Salaries can range from \$5000 per month to \$8000 per month.

7. Are there government grants?

Yes there is the PIC grant for which your company can claim up to 60% cash back or 400% tax incentives (whichever benefits your company more)

8. How long is the course and what examination or certification do I have to sit for?

This is an 8 hour course. There are no examinations. You will be provided a certificate of completion.

9. Is this recognised by MOM

There are only a few petrochemical plants in Singapore and plenty in Malaysia, Indonesia, Australia, Middle East- none of these countries have care about MOM. The companies are more concerned about competency rather than MOM endorsements.
